we know the children will remember and enjoy.

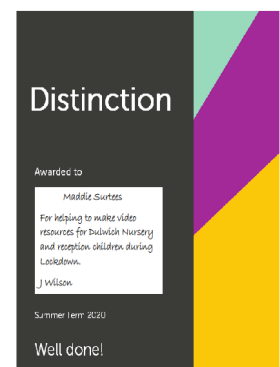


Amazing achievement During lock down Ollie entered a design a
