Term 1

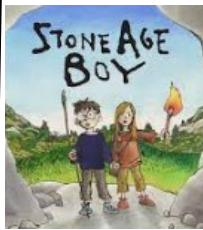
Regular arrangements

## English

In English we begin looking at "Stone Age Boy" with the aim to create our own adventure story, before moving onto poetry with 'Autumn is here'.



## Maths

This term we will begin by developing our knowledge of place value and 3 digit numbers. We will also be focussing on daily numeracy fluency activities too.

## RE

In RE this term we are looking at People of God, looking at links between the story of Noah and how we live in school and the wider world.



## Humanities

In History this term we will be going on a journey back to the 'Stone Age' and discovering what life was like in Britain all those years ago.

In Geography we will be looking at 'Rivers', including a couple of case studies — The River Indus and The River Severn.



## Science

Across the next two terms in Science, we will be looking at 'Electricity'. We will be conducting a variety of experiments and recording and analysing the data we collect.

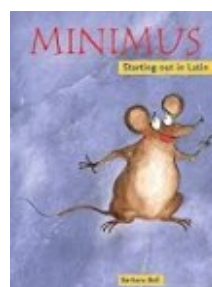


## Computing

In computing this term we will focus on e-safety and looking to develop our understanding of digital devices, with an initial focus on inputs, processes, and outputs.

## Latin

This year key stage 2 will begin learning the highly organised and logical language—Latin. Students will begin with learning how to introduce oneself and greet others. There are also several cross curricular links as we work through the program.
