At Brenchley and Matfield Primary School pupils are formally assessed at the end of Reception Year, at the end of Year 1~phonics, at the end of Year 2 (KS1 SATs) and again at the end of Year 6 (KS2 SATs) for the Government's Statutory Assessment Tests (SATs).

Our school continuously tracks all children's attainment and progress against age related expectations throughout the year and creates lessons to support and develop individual children's learning needs.

In Years 3, 4 & 5 – where formal SATS do not take place - pupils are assessed throughout the year and at the end of each year using non statutory assessments to check on their progress. There is no expectation or requirement for these results to be reported at County or at National level.

Teachers and Senior Leaders use a mixture of formative and summative methods (formative – on-going assessment for learning that takes place each session, summative – formal tests that evaluate, for example, end of unit expectations) to ensure that all children are on track to either meet or exceed their individual targets. These methods may include marking for improvement, self-reflection exercises, peer evaluations, targeted teacher/teaching team evaluation and analysis, etc.

All results are reported to parents throughout the year at our Parent Consultations, with end of year teacher assessments also recorded on individual pupil reports.

The tables below show our Statutory Year 1 Phonics/KS1/KS2 Results for 2017 which are all above County and National Results
